

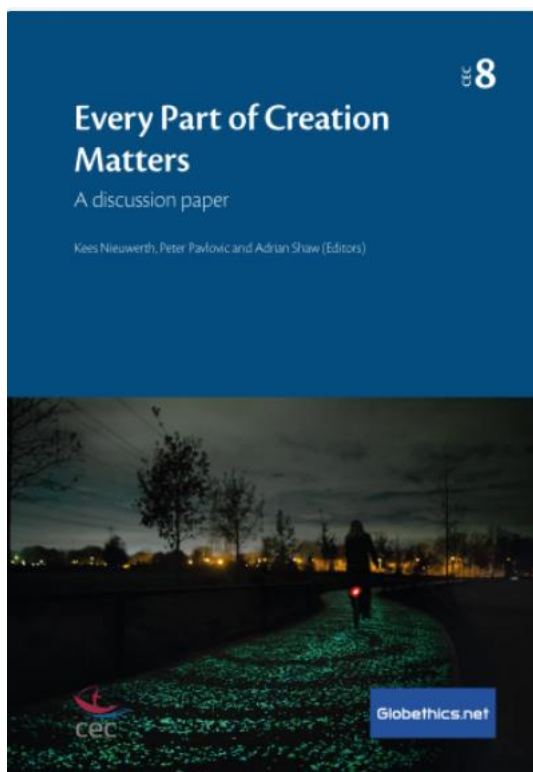
EARTH DAY 2024

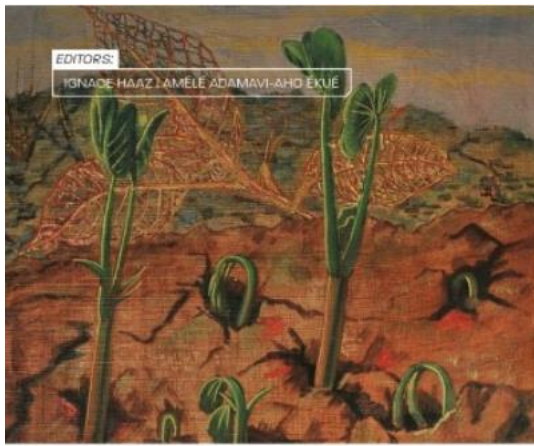

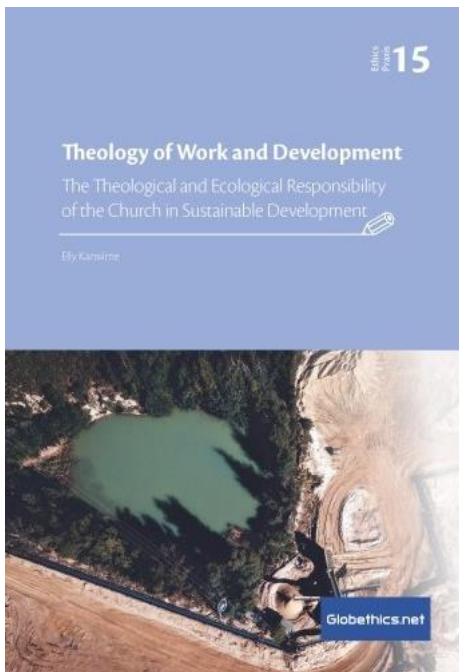
